

## Core Process Measures: Suicide Care Primary Care Setting

Measure	Description
Suicide Prevention Training	All Washington State suicide prevention training requirements met for relevant staff.
Screening Tools	Identification of Risk: Percentage of patients over the age of 13 annually screened for behavioral health conditions, including targeted suicide identification question (e.g. question 9 of the PHQ-9; the first two questions of the C-SSRS).  Assessment of Risk: Percentage of patients with identified risk assessed further for additional risk factors (e.g. complete C-SSRS).
Management of Suicide Risk	Percentage of patients with identified risk who have 'suicide risk' systematically tracked (e.g. separate problem in EHR problem list).
Access to Behavioral Health	Percentage of patients with identified behavioral health needs who received appropriate warm hand-off or referral to behavioral health services.
Follow-up Support	Percentage of patients who received follow-up care after a suicide attempt.
