# 8:45 Presentation: Nehath Sheriff, MPH, MAPS-MCRC Clinic Director of the MAPS-MCRC Clinic

Nehath Sheriff is the Muslim Association of Puget Sound- Muslim Community Resource Center (MAPS-MCRC) Clinic Director. The clinic provides telehealth services (free of charge) for those in need of healthcare during COVID-19, wellness exams, prescription refills and primary care services for adults and children as well as out-patient neurology services.
